In response to the request for financial assistance made by the Government of the Republic of Moldova, for the benefit of the Republic of Moldova, the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development/International Development Association ("World Bank"), acting as administrator of grant funds under the Multi-donor Europe and Central Asia Capacity Development Trust Fund (ECAPDEV TF), has accepted to finance a grant from the ECAPDEV TF to assist the Moldovan Government in the preparation of the Moldova Climate Adaptation and Forestry Project ("Project").

This request for expressions of interest follows the Aide Memoire of the World Bank Team mission in the period of June 20-24, 2016 i.e. – Identification Mission under which it has been agreed to launch the selection procedure (only) of the Individual Consultant to Feasibility and Design Study for the Establishment of two Regional Emergency Command Centers and a National Training Center under the Emergency Situations and Civil Protection Service (ESCPS) of the Ministry of Internal Affairs before having signed the ECAPDEV Grant.

The consultant being part of consultants' team will be responsible for identifying the needs under the Component 2 of Project *Climate information and emergency preparedness* specifically related to Civil Protection Service (ESCPS) of the Ministry of Internal Affairs under the new proposed project as a result of performing of the Feasibility and Design Study for the Establishment of two Regional Emergency Command Centers and a National Training Center under the Emergency Situations and Civil Protection Service (ESCPS). He will coordinate globally with the Project Preparation Team Leader and specifically with the local counterparts for defining the scope related component/activity.

The EMP Management Durabil POP (Project Management Team/PMT) now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (copy of the diploma, description of similar assignments, copy of the certificate(s) confirming attending of the trainings, CV, etc.). This Call for Expression of Interest will lead to the preparation of a Short List of consultants. For evaluation of the expressions of interest the following criteria will be applied:

- Educational background and professional qualification (10 points);
- Experience in experience working with complex solution on both communication and IT (30 points);

- Experience on security and public safety domain by being involved in a large scale implementation project having a similar scope with the specific tasks of feasibility study (40 points);
- Experience in the region (15 points);
- Consultant's successful prior experience in implementing donors' and/or IFIs' sponsored similar project assignments (5 points).

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 and revised July 2014.

The Consultant should meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Has studies on both communication and IT demonstrated by graduation diplomas
- ✓ Has at least 15 years of experience working with complex solution on both communication and IT
- ✓ Has post-graduation technical studies on telecommunication and IT demonstrated by at least one certifications diploma on telecommunication and one in IT
- ✓ Able to demonstrate experience on security and public safety domain by being involved in a large scale implementation project having a similar scope with the specific tasks of feasibility study
- ✓ Has certification as Solution Architect granted by an international organization or as a result of international program
- ✓ Has certification in the area of security of telecommunication and IT solutions demonstrated by diploma issued by an international specialized organization
- ✓ Has knowledge about the processes that govern an IT based organization demonstrated by an international, well known program
- ✓ Has proven knowledge about the process of organizational change management demonstrated by graduation diploma of an international program

The consultancy is require for 12 weeks (40 man-days of input), with potential for extension depending on on-going needs. Some of the work may be completed remotely, but the consultant is expected to spend (14 days) in Moldova directly working with project stakeholders/beneficiary authorities, supporting the PMT and consultants team in Moldova, including on field visits.
